- Apply specialised frameworks to help children with additional needs



Basics of Literacy Support for Children with SEN Before funding: \$2,106 | After funding: \$631.80*

Reading is not a process that can be rushed. "Go as fast as you can, but as slow as you must". Support struggling readers using a structured, explicit and multisensory literacy approach that is responsive to the child's needs.

Programme evaluation is a critical process that helps organisations assess the effectiveness and impact of their programmes, improving their accountability to stakeholders.





Individualised Education Plans for children with SEN Before funding: \$1,404 | After funding: \$421.20*

Equips you with the knowledge and skills to plan, implement and evaluate an intervention for a child with SEN, to bridge the persistent educational gaps.

Planning Literacy Lessons for Children with SEN Before funding: \$2,106 | After funding: \$631.80*

Introduces the fundamentals of planning and delivering literacy lessons for children with SEN. Address literacy challenges through individualised intervention to improve curriculum access.





Supporting Children with Attentional and Hyperactivity Issues

Before funding: \$1,404 | After funding: \$421.20*

This course brings ADHD management, typically done by psychologists, educators, counselors, and caregivers. Participants will learn a multi-faceted approach to supporting children with ADHD.
